GENERAL AWARENESS ON EMINENT ART PERSONALITIES

Something that is created with imagination and skill is called Art.

Some of the famous Eminent Art Personalities which will be introduced in general are:

1. **Leonardo Da Vinci (painter)** - He was a famous painter born on 1452-1519. His famous paintings are- Mona Lisa and Last Super.
 2. **Raja Ravi Varma (painter)** - He was born on 29th April 1848. He was a great painter and artist. Italian and European styles were blended in his painting. He had also depicted many scenes from the Ramayana or Mahabharata.
 3. **Abanindra Tagore (painter)** - He was born on 1871 and died on 1951. He was a landscape and portrait painter and founder of neo-Indian school of painting.
 4. **Amrita Shergil (painter)** - She was on 1913 and died on 1941. She was one of the first modernist painter. She developed a style that combined the best elements of European academic painting
 5. **Pablo Picasso (painter)** - He was a Spanish painter. He was famous for his many line drawing paintings. Some of his famous paintings are “weeping woman”, “Three musicians” and “The three dancers”.
 6. **Zohra Sehgal (stage artist)** - She was a stage artist and renowned for acting in the famous play “EK THI NANI”.
 7. **Amir Khusro (musicologist)** - He was born on 1254 and died on 1325. He was a scholar part and musicologist and also famous for introducing new styles and forms of Hindustani music.
 8. **Mickey Hart (musicologist)** - - He was an American percussionist and musicologist. He was born on 11 Sep 1943. He was a member of the Grateful Dead Band.
 9. **Feroz Khan (play writer)** - He was one of the most accomplished contemporary playwrights who had taken the Hindu theatre by storm with his wonderful plays like Mahatma vs. Gandhi and Salesman Ramlal.
 10. **Auguste Comte (sculpture artist)** - He was born on 19 January 1798 and died on 5 September 1857. His famous work was “The Thinker”. He was a French person. He was regarded as the first philosopher of science in the modern sense of the term.
