THEME OF THE MONTH- “VERSATILE SINGERS”

Versatile: The word versatility describes having many different skills or qualities. Versatility allows you to adapt to many situation or serve many function.

1. **Mohammad Rafi:** He was born on 24 December 1924 and died on 31st July 1980. He was an Indian playback singer and one of the most popular singer of the Hindi film industry .Rafi was notable for his voice and versatility, his songs ranged from classical numbers to patriotic songs, sad lamentations to highly romantic numbers, qawwalis to ghazals and bhajans. He was known for his ability to mould his voice to the persona of the actor.
2. **Kishore Kumar:** He was born on 4 August 1929 and died on 13 October 1987. He was an Indian film playback singer, lyricist, actor, composer, producer, director and screen writer. He is considered one of the most successful playback singers of the Hindi film industry. Apart from Hindi, he sang in many Indian languages including Bengali, Marathi, Assamese, Gujarati, Kannada, Bhojpuri, Malayalam, Odia and Urdu.
3. **Lata Mangeshkar:** She is an Indian playback singer and occasional music composer. She is also the second vocalist, after M. S. Subbulakshmi, to have ever been awarded the Bharat Ratna in 2001, India's highest civilian honour.
4. **David Bowie:** - David Bowie was an English singer and song writer famous for his musical innovation and visual presentation. He was a versatile personality who was also a talented multi-instrumentalist, arranger, painter and actor. His best known album was ‘The Rise and Fall of Ziggy Stardust and the Spiders from Mars’.
5. **Michael Jackson :-** (August 29, 1958 – June 25, 2009) was an American singer, songwriter and dancer. Dubbed the "King of Pop" he was one of the most popular entertainers in the world, and was the best-selling music artist at the time of his death. Jackson's contributions to music, dance, and fashion made him a global figure in for over four decades
