## **PROJECT OF THE MONTH – ‘Biodegradable and Non-biodegradable’**

### ***What is biodegradable?***

Materials or Objects capable of being broken down or decomposed to smaller products by the action of living things (such as animals or microorganisms). After being broken down they are easily absorbed into the soil to become nutrients or elements.

**Examples of biodegradable items Food Waste, Animal And Human Excrement, Manure, Sewage, Slaughterhouse waste, Most paper products, Egg shells, Grasses, Flower/brush clippings etc**

### ***What is non-biodegradable?***

Materials or Objects not capable of being broken down or decomposed to smaller products by the action of living things (such as animals or microorganisms).

Since they cannot be broken down or decomposed they clutter the earth's surface and natural resources and are termed as POLLUTANTS.

**Examples of non-biodegradable items, Plastic Cups, Styrofoam Cups and Plates, Plastic bottles etc.**

### ***What is waste management?***

Waste management is collection, transportation, and disposal of garbage, sewage and other waste products. Waste management involves the process of treating solid wastes and recycling items that don't belong to trash. It is about how garbage can be used as a valuable resource. Reduce; Reuse and Recycle play a very important part in waste management.

These are some of the things that can be recycled and reused.

Cardboard, Cooking Oil, Earth and Rubble, Electrical Appliances, Small Electrical Appliances and Electronic Products  
Garden Waste, Glass Bottles & Jars, Household Batteries, Lead Acid (Vehicle) Batteries, Mixed Recycling, Mobile Phones, Oil, Paper, Pressurized Containers (gas bottles, fire extinguishers, etc), Scrap Metal, Textiles, Tires, Wood

National leader is a man who is a respected leader in national or international affairs. India is a land of great leaders who ruled the country effectively and also by protecting its national interest. National leaders played an indispensable role in changing the perspective of world towards India. Some of the national leaders are-

- **Bal Gangadhar Tilak** was a social reformer and freedom fighter. He was one of the prime architects of modern India and strongest advocates of Swaraj (Self Rule). He was universally recognized as the "Father of Indian Movement".

- **Indira Gandhi** was, undoubtedly, one of the greatest political leaders of India. She was the first and only woman to be elected as the Prime Minister. - **Lala Lajpat Rai** immensely contributed in attaining independence the nation. He helped in establishing few schools in the country. He also initiated the foundation of Punjab National Bank. In 1897, he founded the Hindu Orphan Relief Movement to keep the Christian missions from securing custody of these children. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ZgdSMGzkKLo>
- **Lal Bahadur Shastri** devoted his life for the pride and honor of the country. Shastri was regarded as man of principles. Lal Bahadur Shastri offered his resignation as Union Railway Minister; hours after he was made aware of a train accident that killed around 150 people.

- **Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose** was a freedom fighter of India. He was the founder of the Indian National Army. During pre-independence period Netaji had visited London to discuss the future of India, with the members of the Labor party.

- **Dr. Rajendra Prasad** was a great leader of the Indian Nationalist Movement and also one of the architects of the Indian Constitution. He was elected as the first President of Republic of India. - **Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel** was one of the great social leaders of India. He played a crucial role during the freedom struggle of India and was instrumental in the integration of over 500 princely states into the Indian Union. Despite the choice of the people, on the request of Mahatma Gandhi, Sardar Patel stepped down from the candidacy of Congress president.
