- **Rajasthan**, known formerly by the name Rajputana or the land of the kings, is the largest state in the republic of India.
- Thar Desert also known as the "Rajasthan Desert" and "Great Indian Desert". The Thar Desert runs parallel to the Sutlej-Indus river valley.
- The capital of Rajasthan is Jaipur, also known as Pink City, located on the state's eastern side. Other important cities are Jodhpur, Jaisalmer, Udaipur, Bikaner, Kota, and Ajmer.

- The state of *Rajasthan* is the hub of *famous Camel Safaris* in India
