GENERAL AWARENESS ON: My India My Pride

India is one of the oldest civilizations in the world, spanning a period of more than 4000 years. It witnesses the fusion of several customs and traditions, which is a reflection of rich culture and heritage of the Country.

- ❖ The National Flag of India is a horizontal rectangular tricolour of saffron, white and green; with the Ashoka Chakra, a 24-spoke wheel, in navy blue at it's centre.
- ❖ The song Jana GanaMana is the National Anthem of India which was composed by Rabindra Nath Tagore in 1911, originally in Bengali.
- ❖ The Indian rupee ₹ is the official currency of India.
- ❖ The **Bengal Tiger** was declared as the National Animal of India in April 1973, with the initiation of Project Tiger, to protect the tigers in India.
- ❖ Mango is the National Fruit of India.
- ❖ **There** are 29 **states** and 7 union territories in **India**. The **states** have **their** own government while the union territories are governed by the central government.

Project of the month- Journey of Indian Flag

Timeline of the Indian National Flag: Then v/s now

- ❖ Indian National Flag (1906): The first National Flag of India was hoisted on August 7, 1906, in the Parsee Bagan Square (Green Park) in Calcutta (now Kolkata).
- ❖ **Indian National Flag (1907):** The second flag was hoisted by Bhikaji Cama in Paris and was later exhibited in Berlin at a socialist conference.
- ❖ **Indian National Flag (1917):** This flag was hoisted by Dr Annie Besant and Lokmanya Tilak during the Home Rule movement and was the third flag modified in a row.
- ❖ **Indian National Flag (1921):** During the session of the All India Congress Committee which met at Bezwada in 1921, a young man from Andhra presented this flag to Gandhiji.
- ❖ **Indian National Flag (1931):** A resolution was passed in 1931 to adopt a tricolour flag as our national flag which became the landmark in the Indian History.
- ❖ **Indian National Flag (1947 to now):** This flag which was born on July 22, 1947 was first hoisted at the Council House on August 15, 1947.
