Dear Parents,

With the commencement of this new academic session 2018-19, team DIS welcomes our students to the new session. We wish to provide an environment of happiness, safety and feel comfortable in DIS. We intend to strengthen our bond with parents, which is not possible without your extended support and cooperation.

We wish to let you know that DIS Darpan will give you insight of what we have been doing in the last month and more information happening throughout the year can be seen on our Facebook page and on the website.

Kindly note some key points:

1. The school timings for all students (I to XII) will be **7.50 a.m. to 2.10 p.m.** (Monday to Friday).
2. Attending PTMs for understanding the child's academic and emotional requirements is mandatory for all the parents. To support the school formulate a bond with all the parents, kindly ensure the presence of atleast one parent in all the orientations and events planned specially for parents.
3. Reading other than the syllabus books is declining. To promote the same with a purpose to gain general knowledge, comprehension of language, speed to read, increase vocabulary, we are introducing Newspaper reading, which is one of the most important reading habits to be inculcated in the students from the foundation years of being a student. It not only gives them a wider picture of the current social, economic and political situations but develops higher order thinking skills in students. It is therefore requested to all the parents to other for newspaper subscription in the school.
4. Olympiad examination procedure of your ward is scheduled to begin in the month of July. We will keep informing the dates for the same and various other information regarding the same as and when received by the school.
5. Our school has Wednesdays devoted to club activities in the school. The student is expected to wear house dress during these days. The orientation of clubs to the students will begin from 6.04.218. The student will then be allotted the club that interests them.
6. For better disciplinary functioning of the institution we expect all the students to bring the almanac and scheduled books daily and be in proper uniform.
7. The school is equipped with anti-bullying committee and strictly follows the rules and regulations for not humiliating or embarrassing any student physically and mentally. Tell him/her to report bully or a stalker to the teacher and you.
8. Avoid giving your child smart phone or any such gadget which leads them to excessive social networking. The pros and cons of such gadgets are to be explained to them. Addiction to such gadgets is hazardous to child's mental health. Explain to them their own safety and protection from such gadgets and online sites. Carrying an electronic gadget such as smart watch, laptop, mobile, any sort of intoxicant or addictive, music cd's, electronic storage devices etc are not allowed in the school premises and if found with any student will, bear a consequence of strict actions and confiscation of the object.
9. The student is expected to have neat and tidy haircut. Application of Kajal, lipsticks, perfumes, henna, hair gel is not allowed. Wearing gold ornaments is not allowed in the school for the students.
10. Students of class 6th and above should not wear civil dress on birthdays in the school. They can celebrate the birthday by getting chocolates or toffees for their class mates.
11. As the school faculty is busy nurturing all the children from 7:50 to 2:10, Parents to take prior appointments for meeting faculty members of the school through contacting the reception.
12. We are glad to announce that our school has initiated Yoga for the holistic development of young minds of Dishons. Yogic activities will be conducted in the morning assemblies and classrooms on consistent basis. Yoga has been also formulated as a club too.
13. Our team of teachers has initiated the program "Changing Moves Changing Minds" to collaborate dance and sports sponsored by British Council through a training done in UK. These classes will be done regularly in the school to ensure gender equality and interdisciplinary approach.
14. Academic session for class 11th will commence from 16th April 2018.
15. Ensure that a leave application and medal (if required) is submitted to class teacher through ward's diary or at the reception in case of child is absent during working day.
16. We request you not to promote half day leaves for normal working days and during examination.
