


# SUMMER HOLIDAYS

As it is rightly said;



#### Summer tips:-


- 1) Dress your children in loose, light coloured clothes.



Watering the plants using spray bottles









Raju asked Vijay;

# PROJECT WORK





Step 1-Cut out the front face of a cardboard box.

Step 2- Draw the shape of an eye for the fish's body and 2 hearts inside the same eye for the fins. And cut out both the shapes.

Step2- Print your favourite water background using the printer and stick it to the back of a cardboard box.

Step 3- Stick the hearts to the fish's body and tail, use a black circle for the eye. Now tie a string to the body of the fish making a hole with a punch.

Step 4- Make tiny holes on the top surface of the box and tie the strings with the fishes

Step 5- Finally you can decorate the aquarium with fancy stickers and add pebbles to make it look natural
