### **ENGLISH**

5. Read the newspaper regularly during your holidays. You may utilize the noon time for this activity when you are at home. Cut five pictures from old

newspapers. Paste them in your language notebook and give a caption to each picture.

6. Learn one more poem from the ones given in your text book. Learn question answer of Chapters done in the class with book exercise and exercise done in workbook. **(surprise test in first week of July)**

7. Do one page of handwriting practice daily in a separate rough notebook.
