From the Head of the School's Desk




CLASS ACTIVITIES


COFFEE MEET

STUDENT LED CONFERENCE




SCIENCE EXHIBITION

Safety week was celebrated by school in the month of November for the students, teachers, drivers and conductors of the school. The week was very informative and meaningful.








FIVE EYES FOR ONE HORNET!!


The hornet sees through its two large eyes. Made up of mosaic of a thousand sensoms, these faceted eyes hardly give a precise picture but are especially adapted to detect movement.
