National Leader: An elderly statesman whose advice is sought by government *leaders*.

Bal Gangadhar Tilak (23 July 1856- August 1920) - He was a social reformer and freedom fighter. He was one of the prime architects of modern India and strongest advocates of Swaraj (Self Rule). He was universally recognized as the "Father of Indian Movement".

Project of the month: Non-Degradable and Bio Degradable

Waste management is collection, transportation, and disposal of garbage, sewage and other waste products. Waste management involves the process of treating solid wastes and recycling items that don't belong to trash. It is about how garbage can be used as a valuable resource.



Reduce Reuse Recycle plays a very important part in waste management. There are two types of wastes: Non-Degradable and biodegradable:

Non-Degradable: Materials or Objects that cannot be broken down or decomposed.

They clutter the earth's surface and are termed as POLLUTANT. Waste that cannot be Reduced, Reused or Recycled generally becomes a part of the environment and is around for 100s of years. e.g. plastic cups and bottles.

Bio Degradable: Materials or Objects capable of being broken down or decomposed to smaller products by the action of living things (such as animals or microorganisms). After being broken down they are easily absorbed into the soil to become nutrients or elements.

Examples of biodegradable items- Food Waste, Manure, Sewage, Most paper products, Egg shells, Grasses and Garden waste
