Project of the month : Non-Degradable and Bio Degradable



Bio Degradable - Capable of being broken down (decomposed) rapidly by the action of microorganisms.

- Biodegradable substances include food scraps, cotton, wool, wood, human and animal waste, manufactured products based on natural materials (such as paper and vegetable-oil based soaps).
- Organic Waste - Organic waste such as food, plants, grass clippings and tree leaves are materials that breaks down naturally.
- Food Service Items - Food service items such as trays, disposable cutlery, cups, carryout boxes and even gloves, aprons and hairnets are now being made with biodegradable materials.
- **Non-Degradable** - Non-biodegradable wastes are those which cannot be decomposed or dissolved by natural agents.
- Plastic- Plastics are petroleum-based made from oil and other petroleum products and hence they are dangerous for the environment.
- Stainless steel – It is a group of iron-based metal containing at least 10% chromium (alloy metals). It takes millions of years to dissolve.
