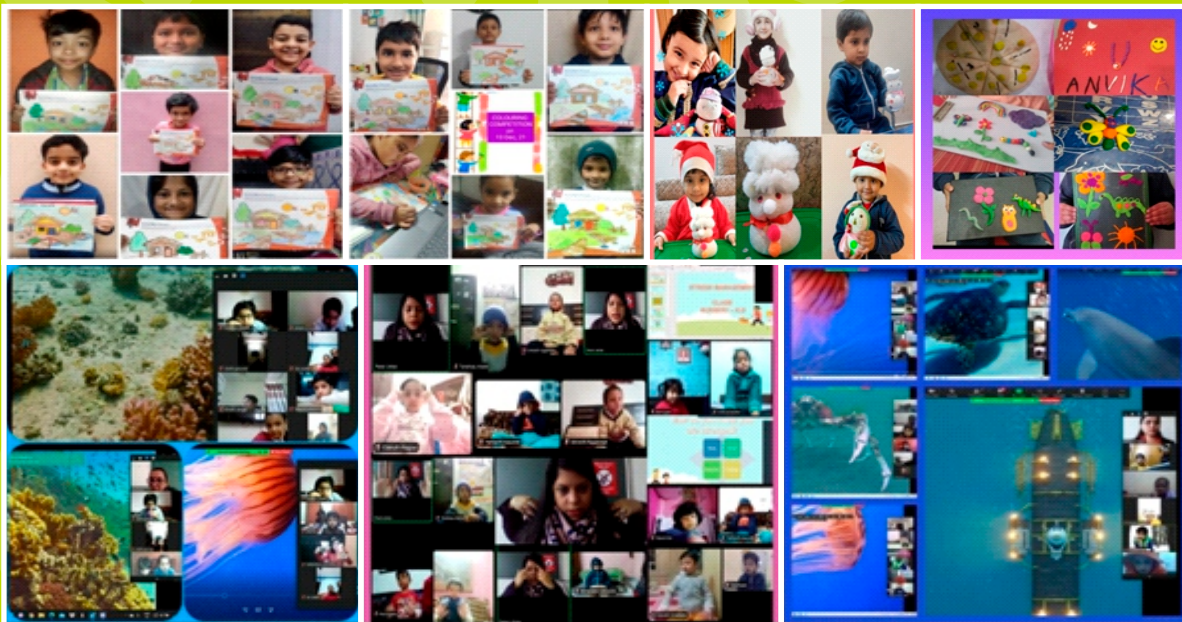

Principal's Message



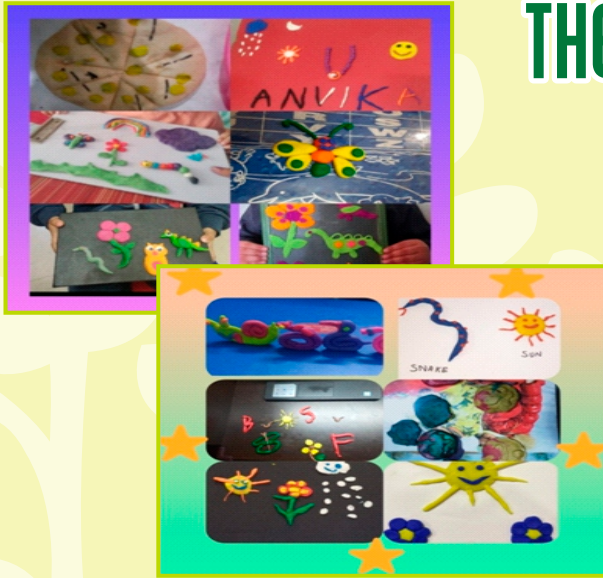
Dear Children,

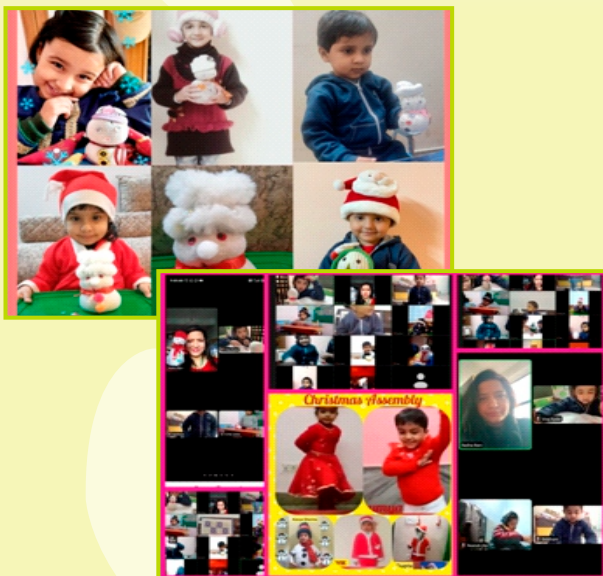
STRESS MANAGEMENT ACTIVITY

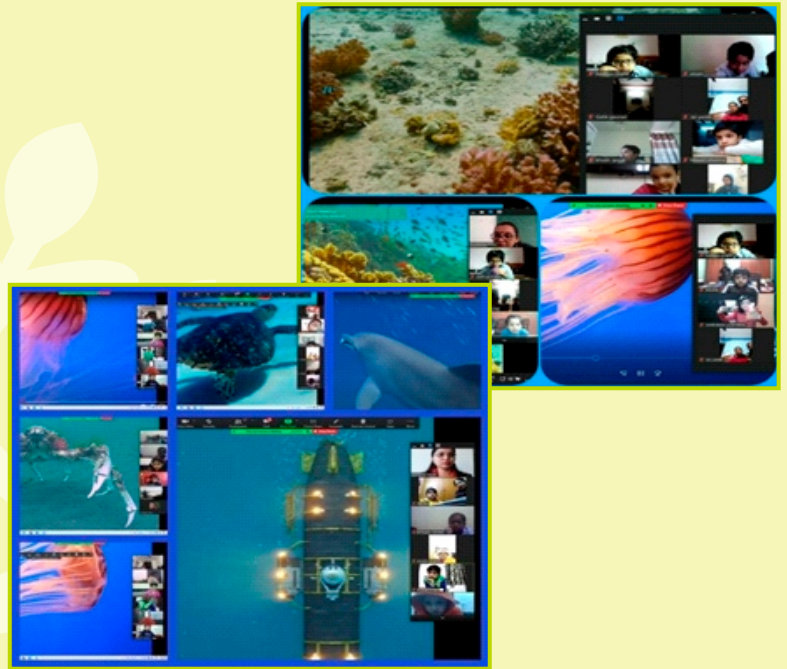
CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION

COLOURING COMPETITION

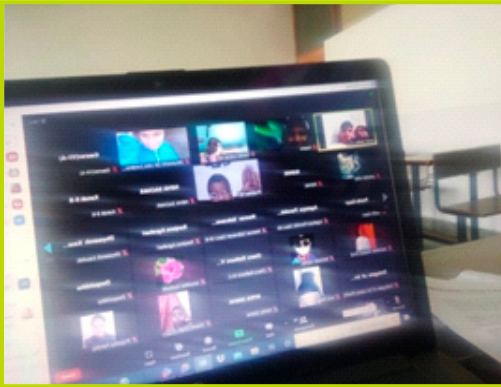

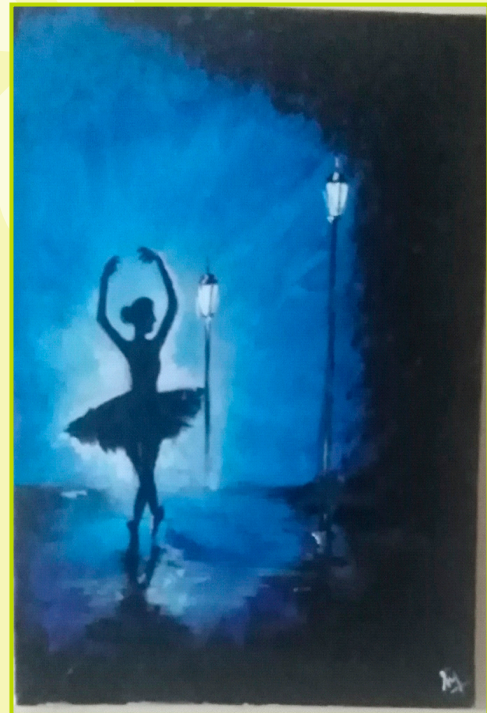
