# FIRE DRILL



#### WHAT IS A FIRE DRILL?

It is a practice of emergency procedures to be used in case of fire

With the hope of reopening the schools very soon, DIS has been conducting various mock drills virtually for the students to refresh their knowledge. A virtual fire mock drill was conducted on 11thOctober, 2021 to sensitize the students about various lifesaving and rescuing techniques in case of emergencies. A power point presentation was prepared to explain the purpose of fire drills, do's and don'ts in case of emergencies, fire extinguishers and their types along with the right use of these extinguishers to save lives. This presentation was followed by a small quiz.

# WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF FIRE DRILL five drifs are intended to ensure, by means of training and reheartal, that: \*People who may be in danger act in a calm and orderly manner \*Propose with responsibilities carry out their tacks to ensure the safety of all connecenced \*Escape routes are used in accordance with a predetermined and practiced plan \*Evapulation of the building is achieved in a speedy and orderly manner \*People will react retionally when confronted with a fire or other emergency at

#### TYPES OF FIRE EXTINGUISHER

#### DURATION OF EXTINGUISHER= 20-30 secs

- Carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>): For electric fires
- Foam Extinguisher: Suitable for class B and kitchen fires
- Dry powder extinguisher; Universal extinguisher

# **EARTHQUAKE DRILL**

Mock drills and evacuation drills are executed at the school to create awareness and preparedness during calamities. To train students to be alert, quick, and responsible, to follow instructions, to maintain calm,

and to avoid panic, to avert stampedes and casualties, an earthquake drill and preparedness activity was held on 15th November. The main aim of the drill was to apprise students on how to perform – Drop, Cover, and Hold-on, a quake safe action designed to protect lives and prevent injuries from falling and flying objects. Students were trained to reach the safe designated areas like under the desk and in the open space in case of any emergency.
